SPUC Fellowship/Training Committee

The responsibilities of the Fellowship/Training Committee include:

- Maintaining a list of fellowships in the U.S. for inclusion on SPUC's website
- Updating the fellowship application contact information
- Fielding fellowship-related questions from external sources
- Encouraging fellowship programs to have their participants submit abstracts for consideration for presentation during SPUC's Annual Conference.
- Other fellowship-related tasks or initiatives as mutually agreed upon by the Chair and the Board of Directors.

The committee works with all disciplines and other committees to help foster the goals of all SPUC members, SPUC committees, and the SPUC board.

SPUC's Fellowship/Training Chair will be appointed by the President subject to approval by the Board. The Chair is responsible for scheduling committee meetings, developing agendas and content, written summaries of committee meetings and all communication with committee members. The Chair reports to the Board Liaison any updates or requests for Board approval or assistance prior to each of the Board of Directors meetings.
